Thank you for returning your responses to our consultation about bubble sizes and school provision. The outcome of the survey was -

95% of those taking part in the survey selected Model 1. 150 members of the school community voted - 95 of these are Parents and Carers.

This means that we will continue with the tight bubbles we currently have in place and will finish early each Friday -

11.30am - Key Stage 4 and 5

Start times will remain the same.
